

REFRACTION

A ***refraction*** is the part of an eye exam to determine the prescription for corrective lenses. Without a refraction, we cannot provide a prescription for corrective lenses.

Historically, most insurance plans DO NOT PAY for this portion of an eye examination. If your plan does not pay for glasses or contact lenses, they most likely will not pay for a refraction. We do not include this procedure in our routine examination charge.

You may elect not to have the refraction done, however, we will be unable to provide a prescription for glasses.

If you do have a refraction done, there will be a \$30.00 charge at the time of service, in addition to any co-payment or other non-covered fees.

We will file this charge with your insurance company. Should they reimburse us this charge or a part of this charge , we will send you a refund.

A refraction is a very important part of an examination if you require corrective lenses. We appreciate your understanding in this matter.
